When you want to start insect control, start with as bug-free a barn as possible.

**2**

Use a fogger or hand/back sprayer and spray 75ml of liquid per 100m<sup>3</sup> against flying insects

**3**

Remove fly breeding sites (manure crusts in the pit) by dissolving 2kg per 100m<sup>3</sup> slurry improver in ample water and treat the pit contents

**4**

Start larval treatment with MS Madendood this week. Mix it with water (dosage: 250g per 10m<sup>2</sup>) and pour/spray it over the grids

**5**

Repeat larval treatment with MS Madendood in week 18 (29 April to 5 May)

**6**

Start by treating the adult fly. Apply MS Thia-Fly to the yellow cardboard

**7**

Repeat again the larval treatment with MS Madendood in week 24 (10 to 26 June) and week 30 (22 to 28 July)

**8**

Enjoy a fly-free stable!
