When you want to start insect control, start with as bug-free a barn as possible.



2
Use a fogger or hand/back sprayer and spray 75ml of liquid per 100m³ against flying insects



3
Remove fly breeding sites (manure crusts in the pit) by dissolving 2kg per 100m³ slurry improver in ample water and treat the pit contents



4
Start larval treatment with MS Madendood this week. Mix it with water (dosage: 250g per 10m²) and pour/spray it over the grids



5
Repeat larval treatment with MS Madendood in week 18 (29 April to 5 May)



6
Start by treating the adult fly. Apply MS Thia-Fly to the yellow cardboard



7
Repeat again the larval treatment with MS Madendood in week 24 (10 to 26 June) and week 30 (22 to 28 July)



8
Enjoy a fly-free stable!
